4. Legal basis and purposes of the processing of personal data

4.1 General

We may disclose your personal data at the request of any legal competent authority, or even on our own initiative, if we believe in good faith that passing on the data is necessary to comply with relevant and applicable regulations, or to defend or protect our rights and/or those of our customers.

6. Safety measures
